-Disseminating the results of the research.

The activities and the results of the projects during 16th of December 2015 and 4th of October 2016 are organised in the present report in chapters, points and subsequent points for a fluid presentation.

Chapter I. Research activity in the project

1. Research activities, documenting stages related to the activities of the project

To complete the identification of old Romanian books, the members of the research team travelled in Romania and abroad (Biblioteca Academiei Române, Cluj-Napoca branch; Biblioteca Naţională a României Bucureşti; Arhivele Naţionale-Direcţia Judeţeană Braşov; Muzeul Judeţean Târgovişte; The National Library of Rome, Italy; (Italia), Szechenyi National Library in Budapest, Hungary).

After collecting the data, we completed the inventory and the analysis of the materials related to old Romanian books in the Habsburg Empire. The process generated the main work of the project: **Cartea românească veche în Imperiul Habsburgic (1691-1830).** Recuperarea unei identități culturale, *a*uthors Ioan Chindriş, Niculina Iacob, Eva Mârza, Anca Elisabeta Tatay, Otilia Urs, Bogdan Crăciun, Roxana Moldovan, Ana Maria Roman-Negoi, Cluj Napoca, Editura Mega, 2016, 1016 pages, ISBN 978-606-543-733-3, CNCS B category, code PN-II-ACRED-ED-2012-0368. The book presents on 1016 pages all the printing centres we researched together with all the books, their detailed description and bibliographical references. The book represents an unique instrument for the Romanian historiography dedicated to the subject, very useful for researchers, students, MA and PhD students and also for the

public, who, in a precise and organised manner, may easily access a consistent segment of the national cultural patrimony – the old Romanian books

The dissemination activities include the participation of the team members to national and international conferences, publishing the studies and articles especially in BDI indexed magazines. We also published the results of the project to CNCS B accredited publishing houses.

During stage VI, based on the results generated by the research, the members of the project ensured the dissemination of the results according to Chapter 2 of the Report.
