Chapter I. The research activity inside the Project.

1.1 Internationl stages:

Anca Elisabeta Tatay, Venice (Italia), 14.08.2013-04.09.2013: documentation in order to contextualize the engravings in the old Romanian writings within the European books (15th-19th century). I attempted to find the bibliography related to the theme and to study the old European writings, particularly those of Venice, found in the Marciana Library and in the Library of the Correr Museum.

1.2 National stages:

Anca Elisabeta Tatay, Cluj-Napoca, Alba Iulia, Bucharest: documentation in order to find the engravings in the old Romanian books printed in the typographies of Bucharest between 1582-1830.

The bibliography referring to old Romanian Writings (1508-1830) and particularly to that of Bucharest has been thoroughly examined. The number of books of Bucharest for the period under investigation, on the basis of the existent bibliography: about 350 titles has been established.

In the libraries of Cluj (The Library of Romanian Academy, The University Central Library), of Alba Iulia (The Library of the Union Museum, The Library of Ortodox Bishopric, The Battyaneum Library) and of Bucharest (The Library of the Romanian Academy) the old Romanian writings of Bucharest were examined and inventoried and the graphic elements were photographed.

In addition, based on the bibliography found abroad (Venice) but also in the country, I attempted to attain objectives 1 and 2 (1. The Romanian typographies and their book production (1508-1830) in the Central-eastern European background; 2. The cultural and historical background of Bucharest for the late 16th century – the beginning of the 19th century) and I started to work for the 3rd objective.
